

Faculty Disclosure Statement

The American Thoracic Society is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education as a provider of continuing medical education (CME) for physicians. As an accredited provider, the American Thoracic Society (ATS) must ensure balance, independence, objectivity and scientific rigor in its educational activities. All faculty participating in an ATS sponsored CME activity are asked to disclose (a) the existence of any significant financial or other relationship with the manufacturer(s) of any commercial product and/or providers of commercial services discussed in an educational presentation, and (b) "off-label" uses of substances or products included in the presentation that are not approved in the United States.

The intent of this disclosure is not to prevent faculty with a significant financial or other relationship from participating in a CME activity, but rather to provide participants with information on which they can make their own judgments. It remains for audience members to determine whether presenters' interests or relationships may influence the presentation. The American Thoracic Society does not view the existence of these interests or commitments as necessarily implying bias or decreasing the value of the presentation.
